## Coronavirus Stipulations for “Fall Cleanup” Event for Allegheny Township, Westmoreland County

Allegheny Township Board of Supervisors and township residents wish to safely hold another Electronics Recycling event. Current CDC and PA Department of Health guidelines will be applicable which include the following safety standards:

- \*the event will only occur if Westmoreland County is not in the Red Phase as mandated by Governor Wolf
- \*before the event begins, each participating staff member will have their temperature taken and will complete the daily Coronavirus COVID-10 Screening form as required by Township policy
- \*staff members and residents will be required to maintain acceptable social distances of six (6) feet or shall be required to wear a mask; Masks will therefore be required during payment and when instructions are provided by staff.
- \*residents will not be permitted to exit their vehicles
- \*disinfecting of surfaces shall occur multiple times during the event

Allegheny Township anticipated between 150-200 residents to attend the event. The Public Works area has sufficient space available to prevent traffic from extending onto the roadway.
