Motion by Supervisor Morabito to Rename the Municipal Building's "Community Hall" to "Mable V. Mazza Community Hall"; second by Supervisor Steele; motion carries

Mr. Leyland gave commentary on PennDot funding of State Police, State redistricting and appreciates that we have a local police department.


Supervisor's Comments
