**Amendment to Resolution 01-2005 provides that anyone wishing to offer comment during the public comment period is required to obtain a Public Meeting Registration for Public Comment form from the Secretary, fill it out and return it to the Secretary. The Secretary will present the forms to the Chairman, who will randomly recognize each person. Each person may speak one time during the public comment period for five minutes.
