Motion by Supervisor Steele to Approve Resolution #10-2022, Establishing the Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for the Allegheny Township Police Pension Plan for the 2023 Municipal Budget at \$44,446 and setting the 2023 Minimum Municipal obligation (MMO) Allegheny Township, Westmoreland County Pension Plan (65-006-5N) for non-uniform employees at \$76,299; second by Supervisor Morabito; motion carries.

Motion by Supervisor Morabito to Approve Resolution #13-2022, Westmoreland County District Attorney Conveyance of Grant Dollars in the amount of \$1,029 for a communication headset for one SWAT team member; second by Supervisor Steele; motion carries.

Motion by Supervisor Steele to Purchase IWORQ Code Enforcement software module for \$5,500 annually and waiving the installation and training fee for existing membership; second by Supervisor Morabito; motion carries.


**Supervisor's Comments**
