### **Action Items**

Motion by Supervisor Korns to appoint Brenda Troup as the Zoning Officer and Code Enforcement Officer; second by Supervisor Pollick; motion carries.

Motion by Supervisor Pollick to approve the annual COSTARS submission of 1200 tons of rock salt for the 2024-2025 season; second by Supervisor Korns; motion carries.

Motion by Supervisor Korns to authorize the Interim Township Manager to prepare and advertise for the adoption of the International Property Maintenance Code and to repeal and replace the Township's current property maintenance related codes; second by Supervisor Pollick; motion carried.

Supervisor Korns discussed the need for the Township to carefully review the IPMC as many communities only adopt portions of it.

Motion by Supervisor Pollick to approve the Township's bidding for a used tractor and boom mower on Municibid, amount to be sealed until bid is successful; second by Supervisor Korns; motion carries.

Motion by Supervisor Korns to authorize the Solicitor to work to locate the owner of 63 Ridge Avenue with the intent for a demolition approval for the Township; second by Supervisor Pollick; motion carries.

Supervisor Korns discussed the efforts that have been made to track down property owners over the last few months and expressed his desire to work with the Solicitor closely.
